

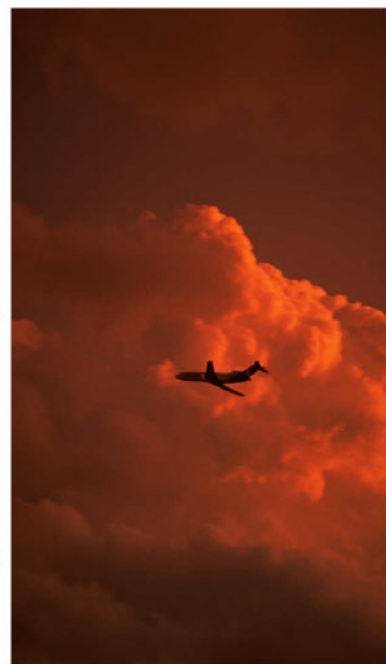
A FOUND FAREWELL!
