In a recent evaluation letter to FCI Mendota Federal Prison last month, the prison's volunteer program was applauded by headquarters. Specifically mentioned for special honor, was Dick Stoltz's Grief Share Program. Because of its potential effectiveness to aid the prisoner through the grief-stricken times caused by the passing of a loved one, the Atwater Federal Prison chaplain is interested in having Dick bring this portion of Christ Behind The Wall Prison Ministry to their prison. APRIL ACTIVITY

In April, eleven volunteers held 39 classes, out of 58 scheduled (67%) consisting of 561 students. Also, Bennie Williams preached six times for a total of 345 worshippers attending. We gained a new volunteer at the Stanislaus County Jail in Modesto and a former volunteer rejoined us at the Madera County Jail. Also, we've gone international!! We are now mentoring and providing material for Pastor John Fefegula's Christian Community Fellowship's prison ministry program in Monrovia, Liberia, Africa.
